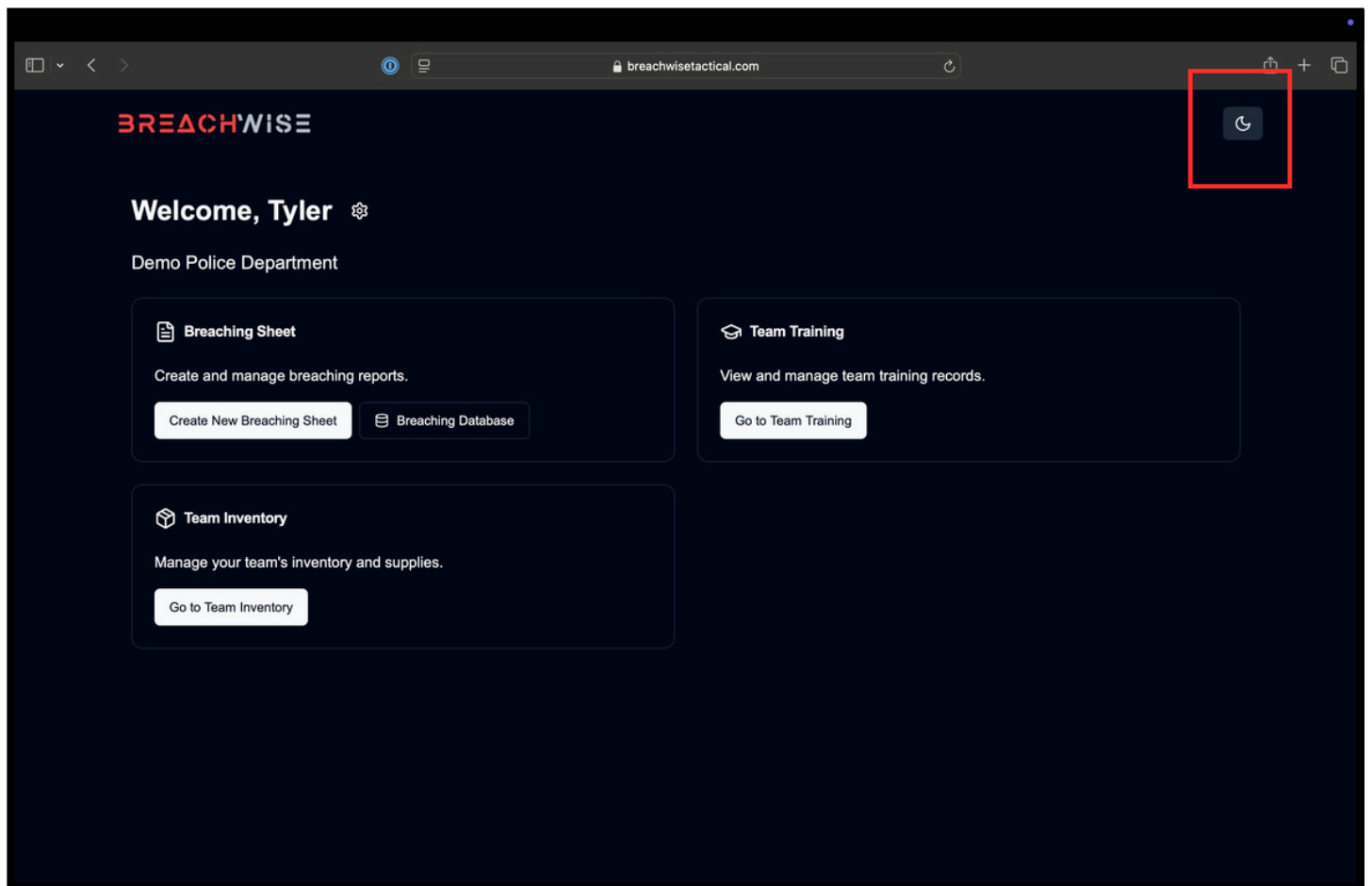
Dashboard Page

After logging in, you will be directed to your Dashboard.

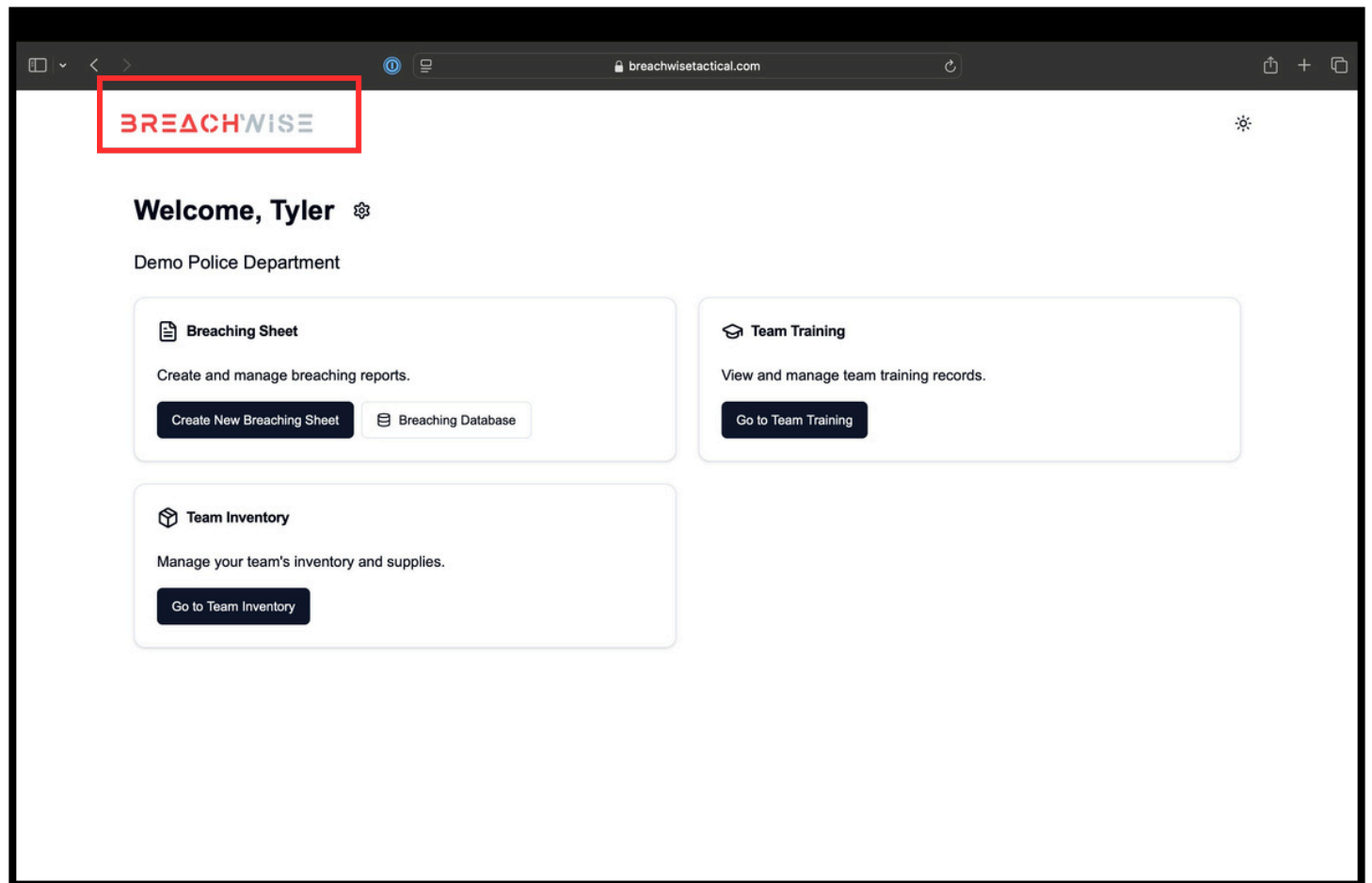
This is the main navigation area for BreachWise and will get you to everywhere you have the permissions to access



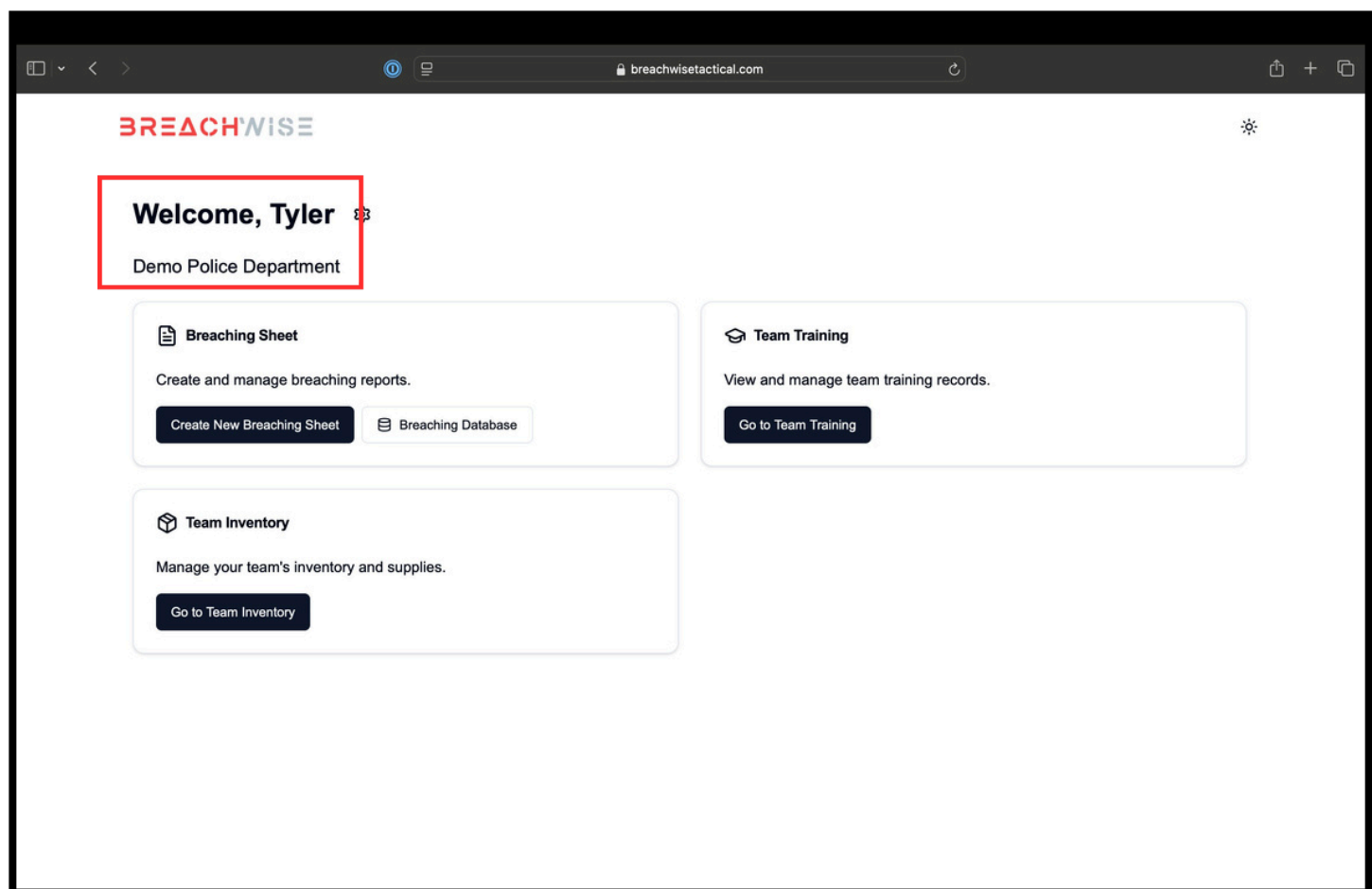
Clicking the sun or moon icon in the upper right corner will change the user interface between dark mode and light mode



You can click on the BreachWise logo from anywhere in the site after being logged in to return to the Dashboard

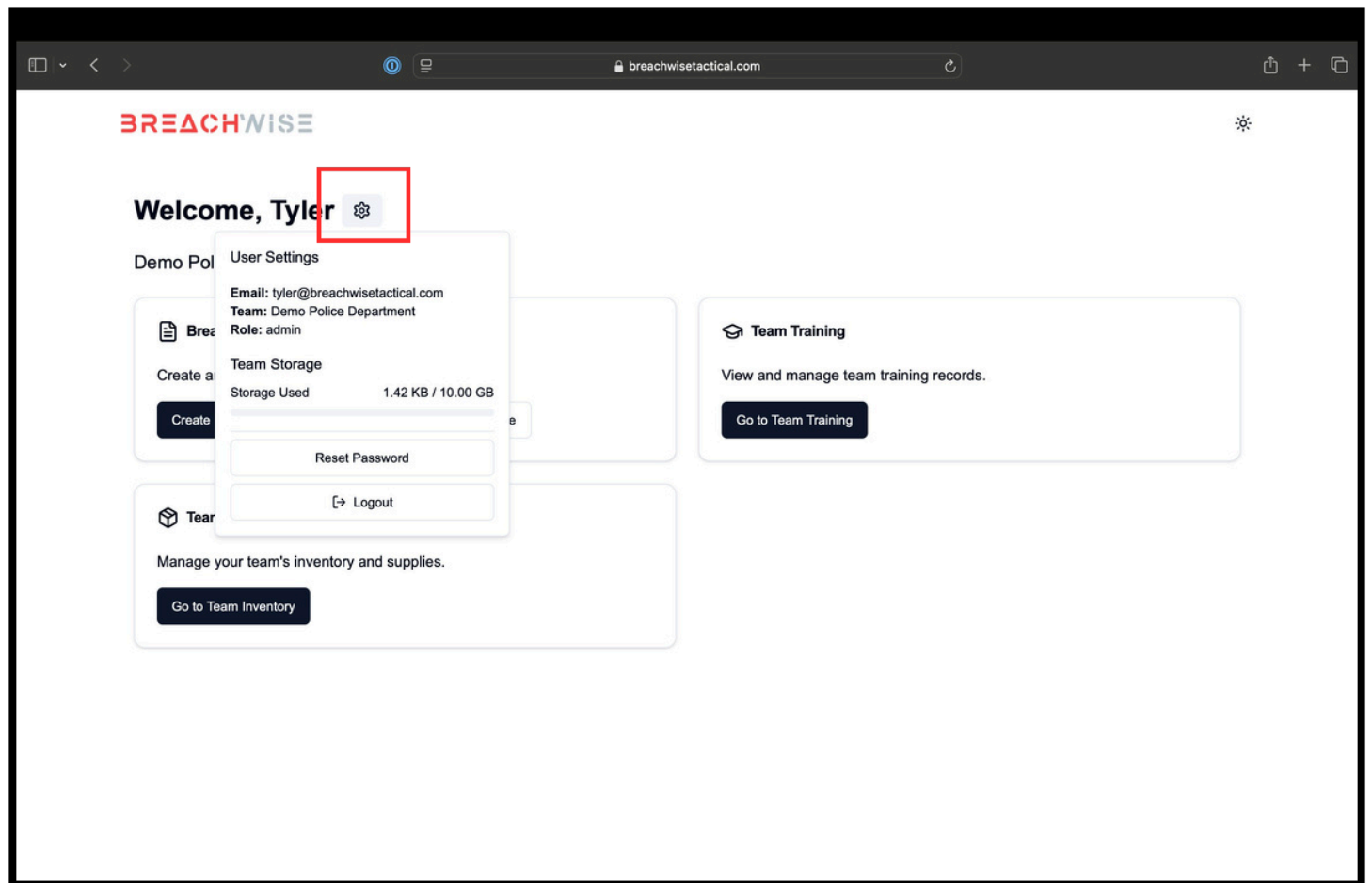

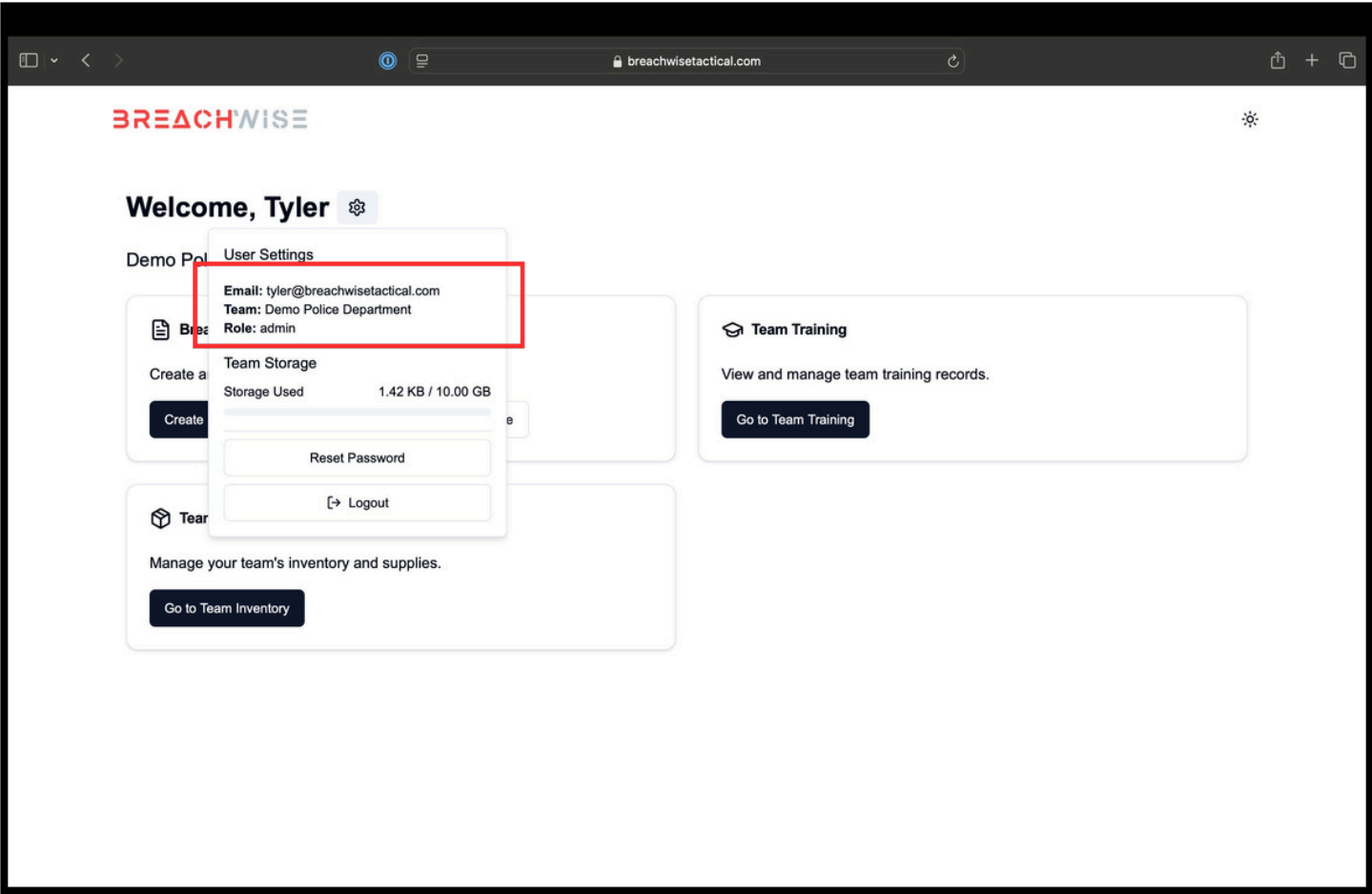

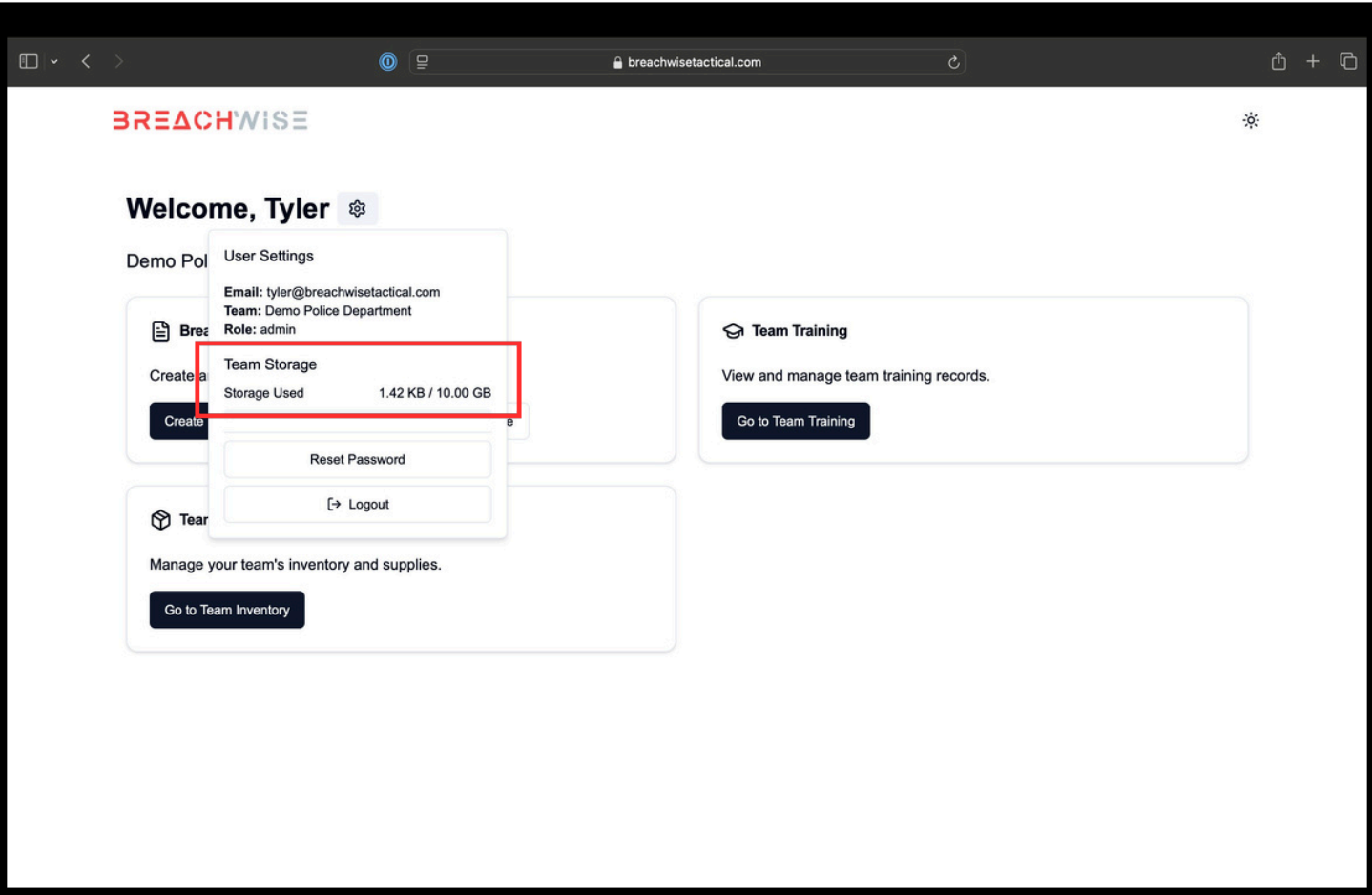
Clicking on the settings cog next to your display name will bring up your user menu



The top of the drop down will display your user email address, your assigned team/agency, and the role you have within your team.

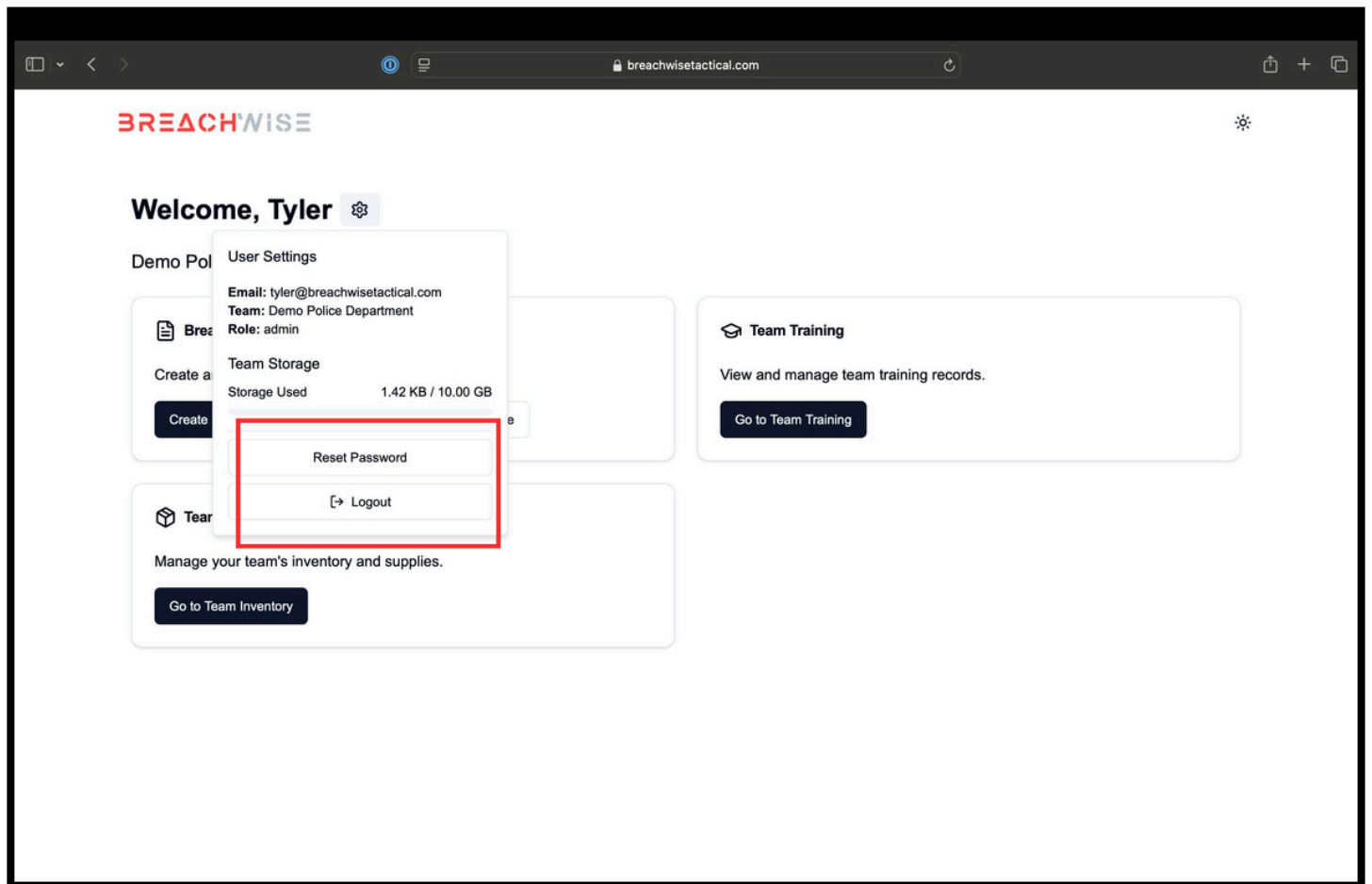


The next area displays how much storage your team has allotted to them and how much is currently being used. Total storage is based on what tier the team is subscribed to.



The 'Reset Password' button will immediately send you an emailed link to reset your password, similar to the forgot password function on the log in page.

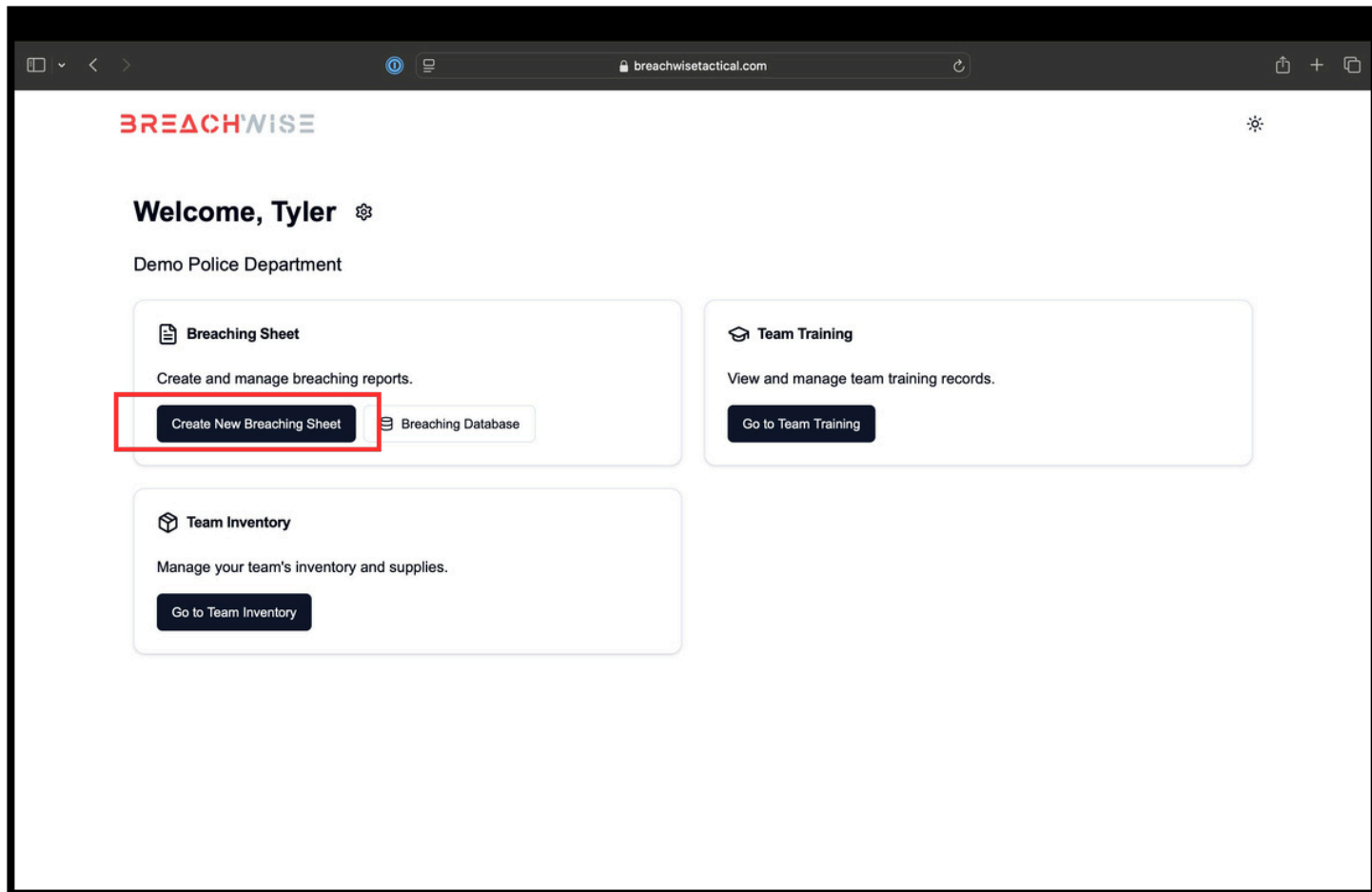
The 'Logout' button will log you out of the system

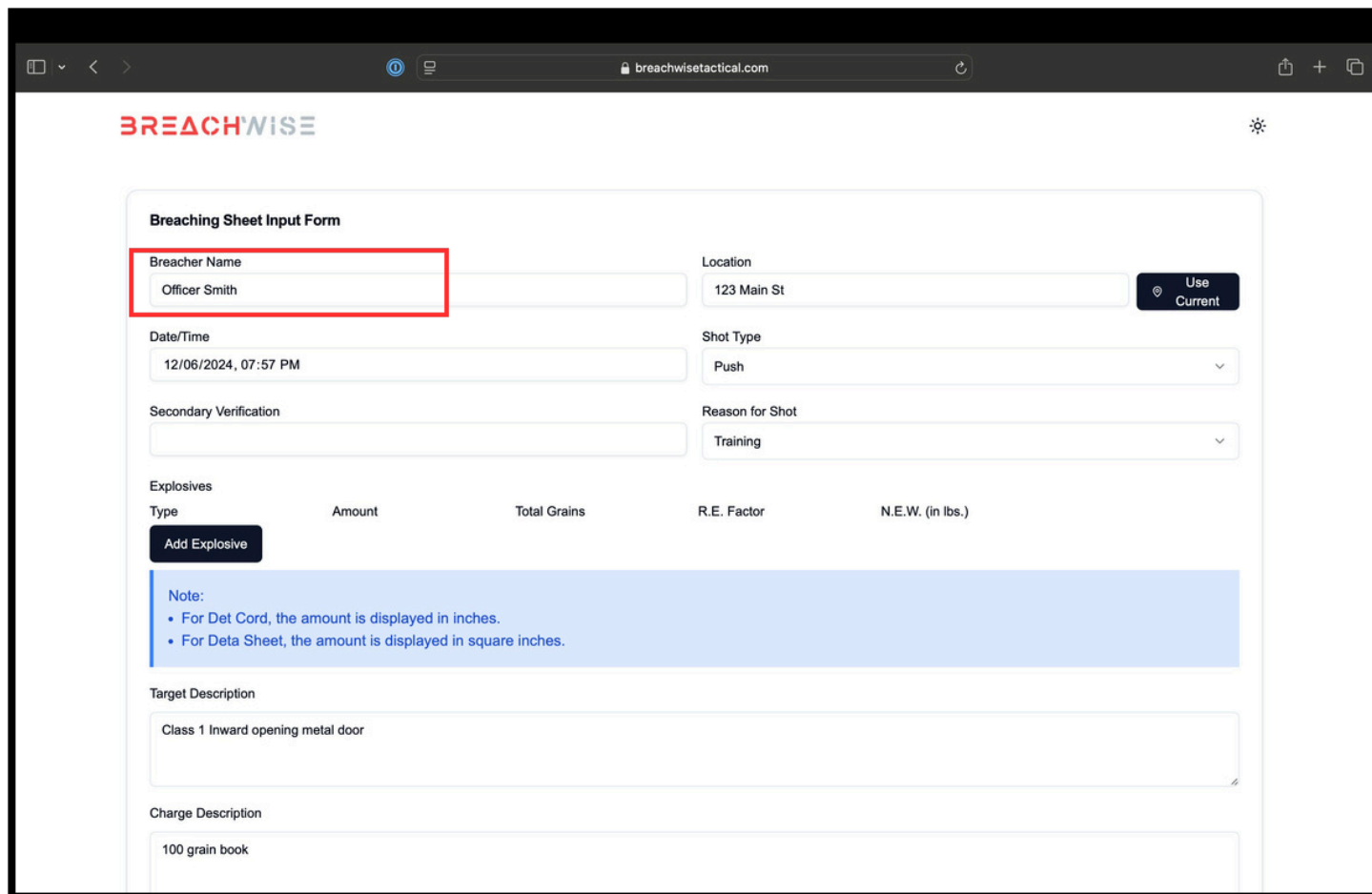

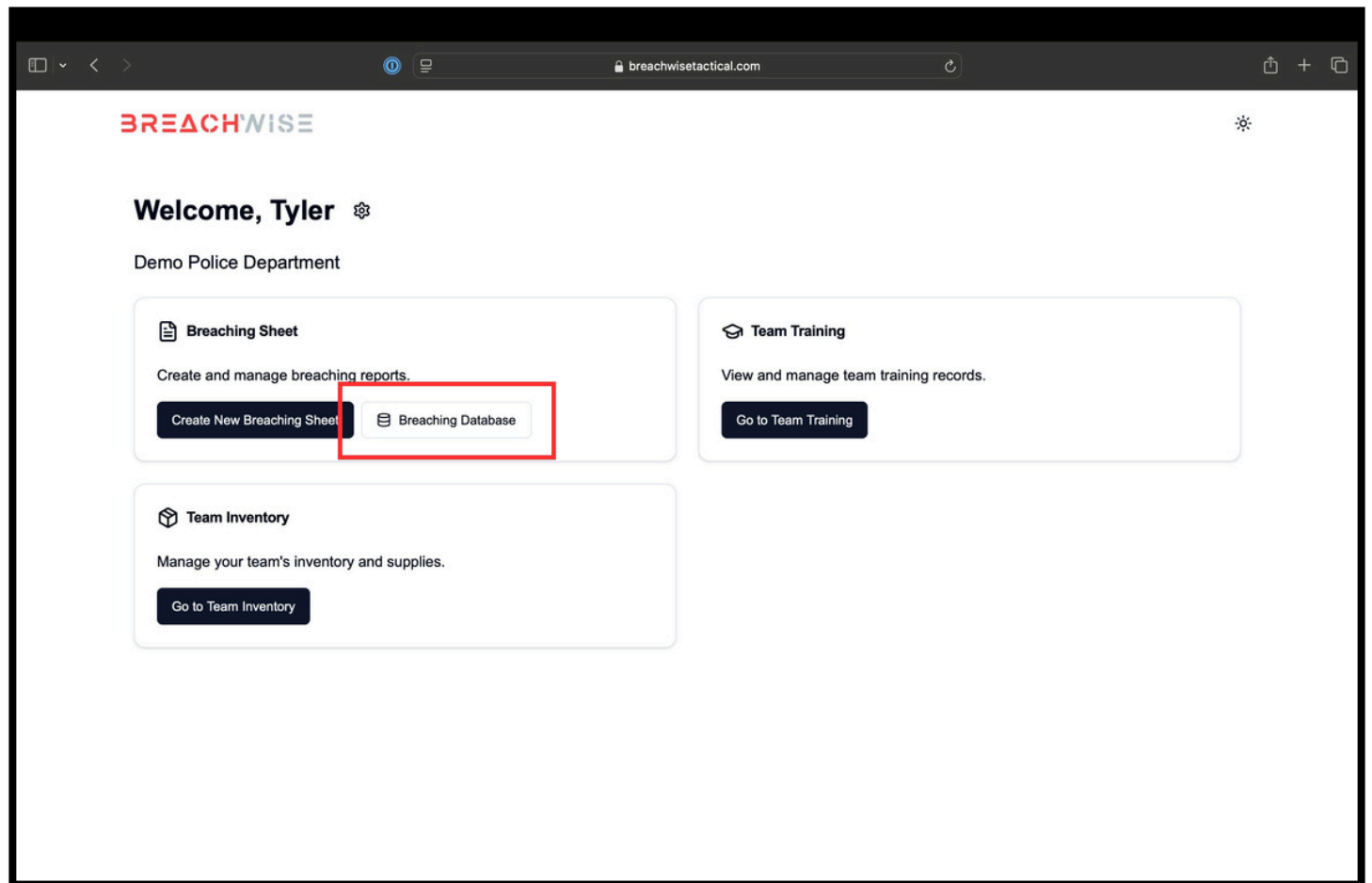

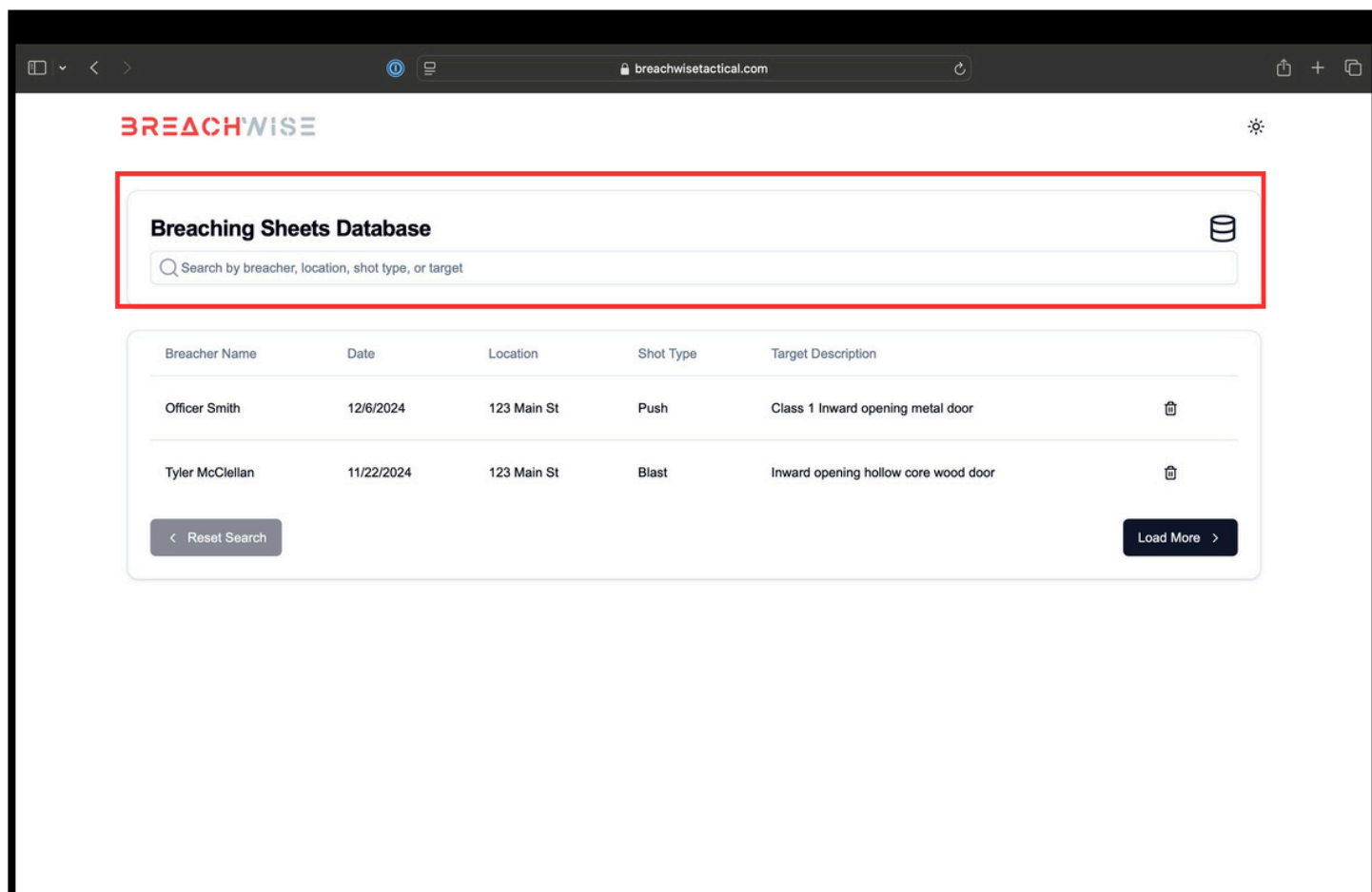

Searching and Reviewing Breacher Reports

The Breaching Sheets Database features a way to search and retrieve past breaching reports, and view and print reports. This allows for quick search of past shots or targets to assist in selecting the right shot operationally. It also allows printing and creating PDF versions for legal or other records reasons.

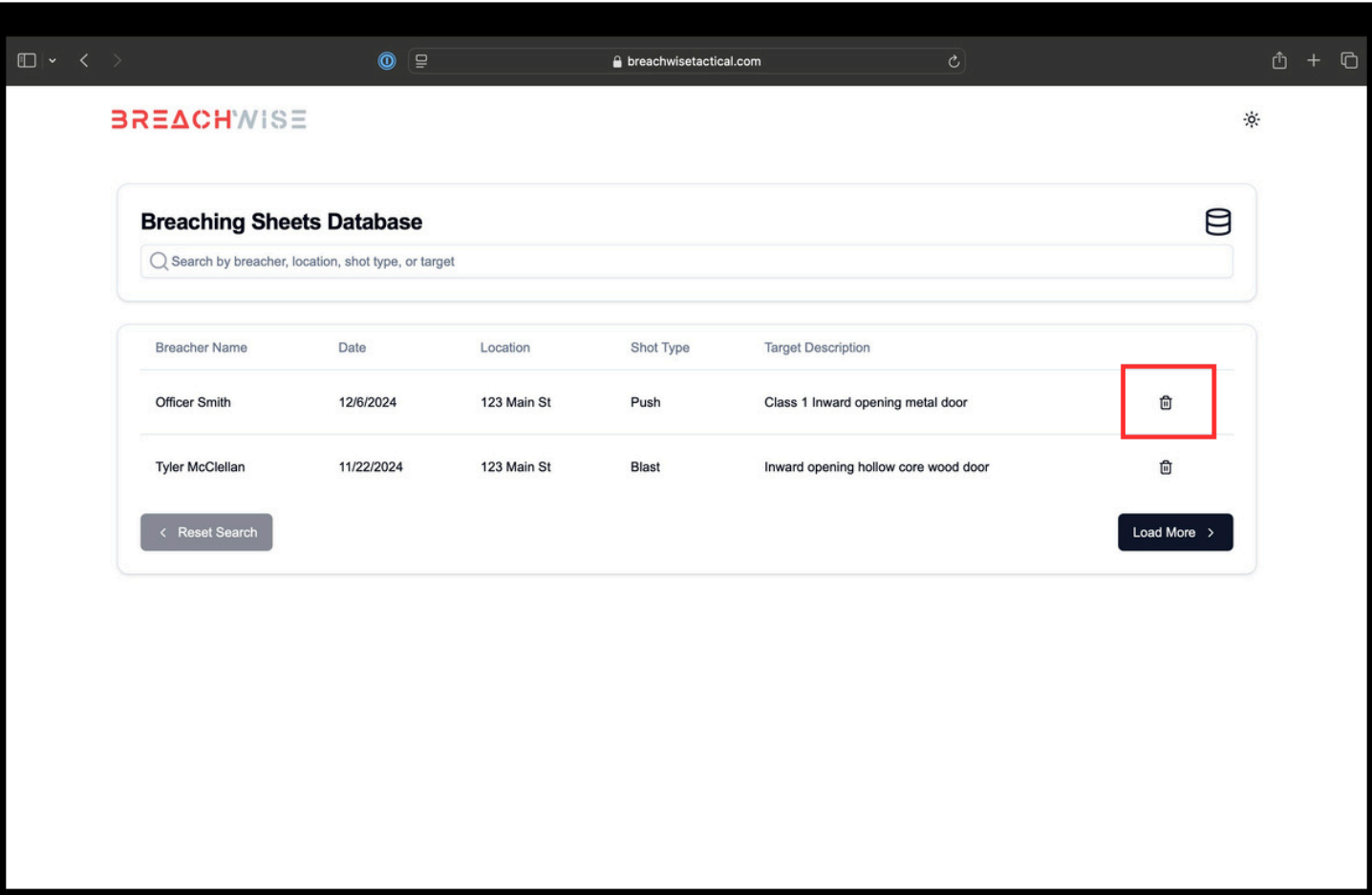

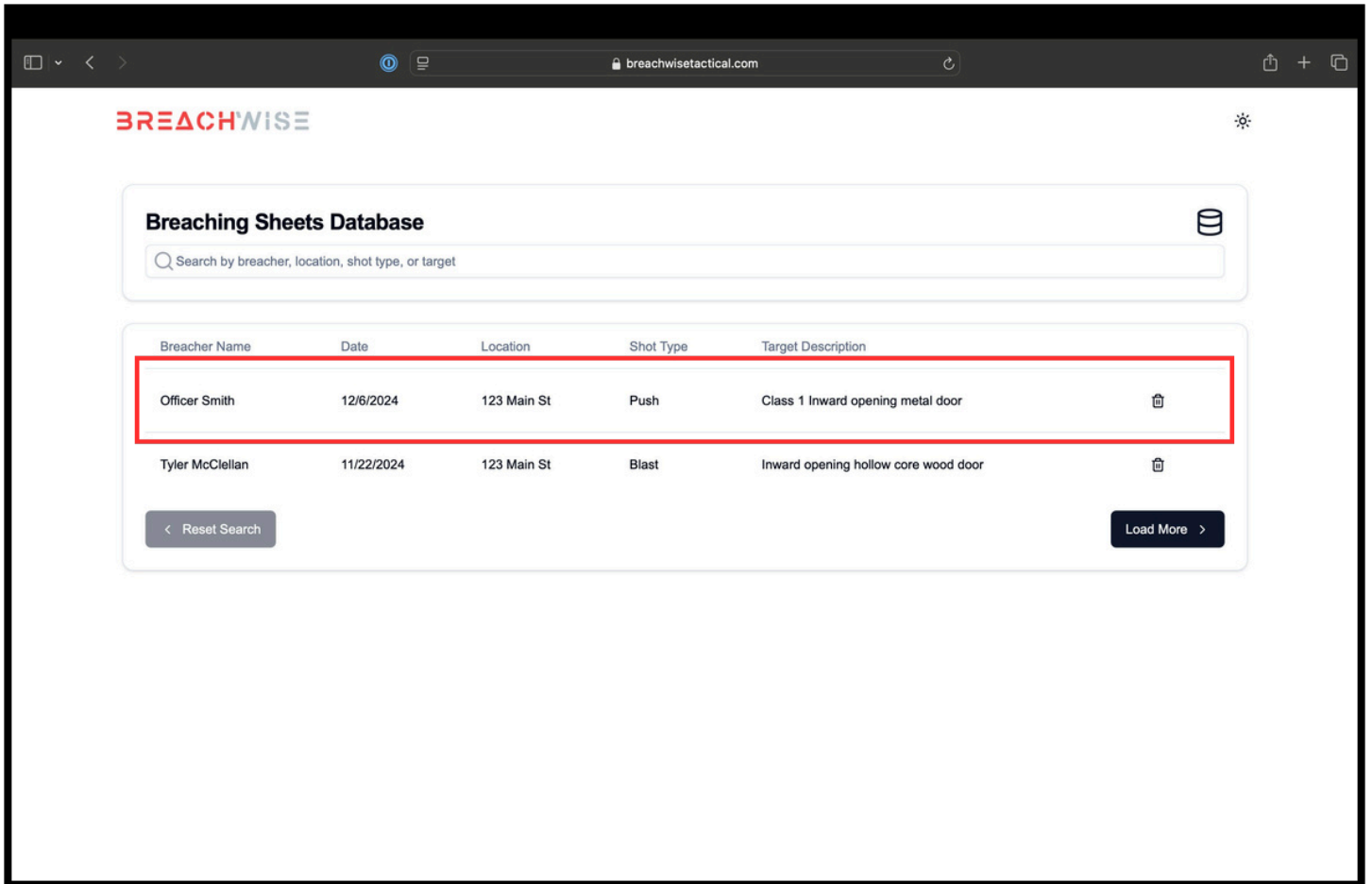
Deleting Breaching Sheets

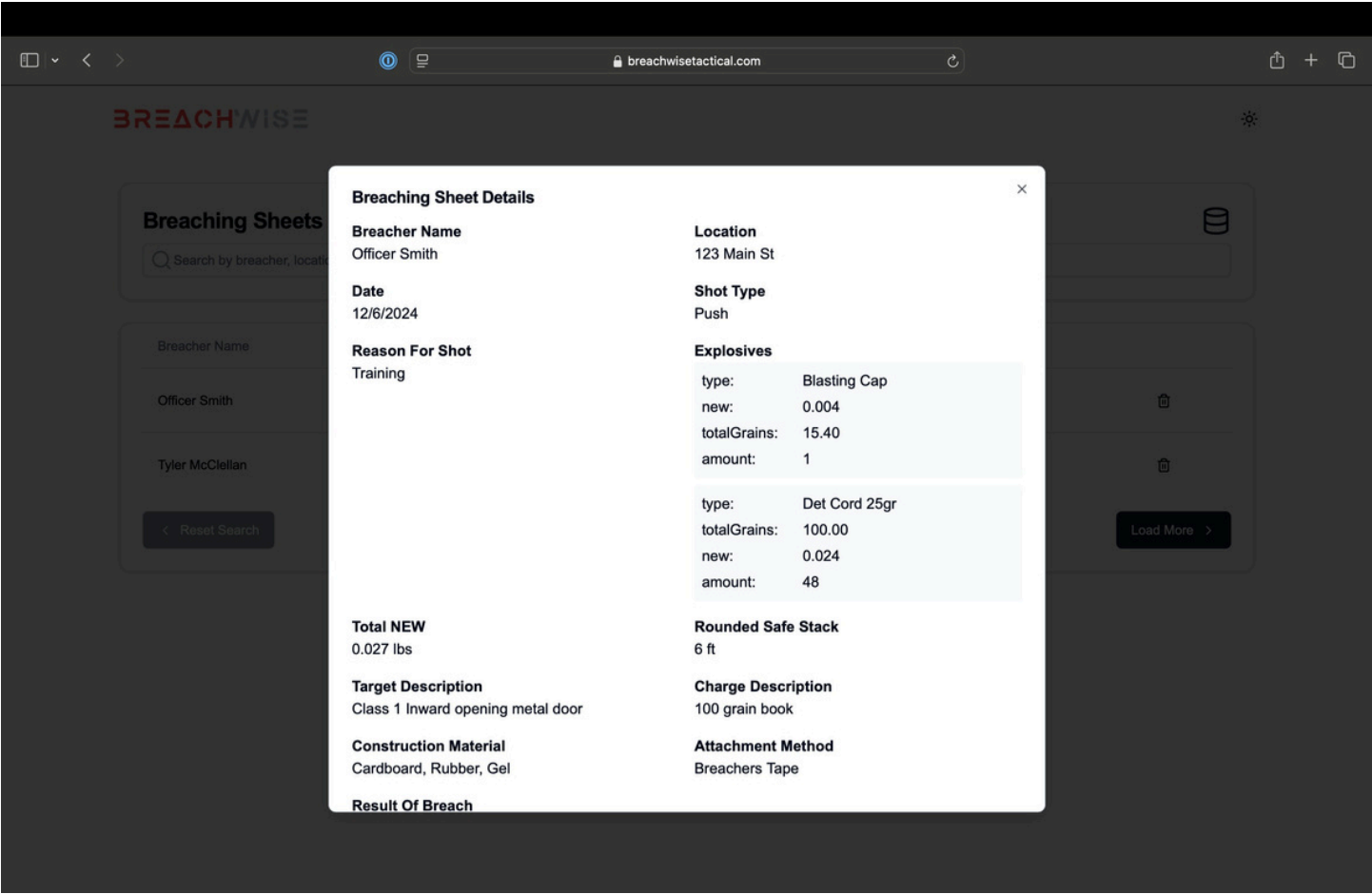
Note: Due to the destructive nature of this action, and to ensure the principle of least privilege, the delete button will only appear and be accessible by team administrators.

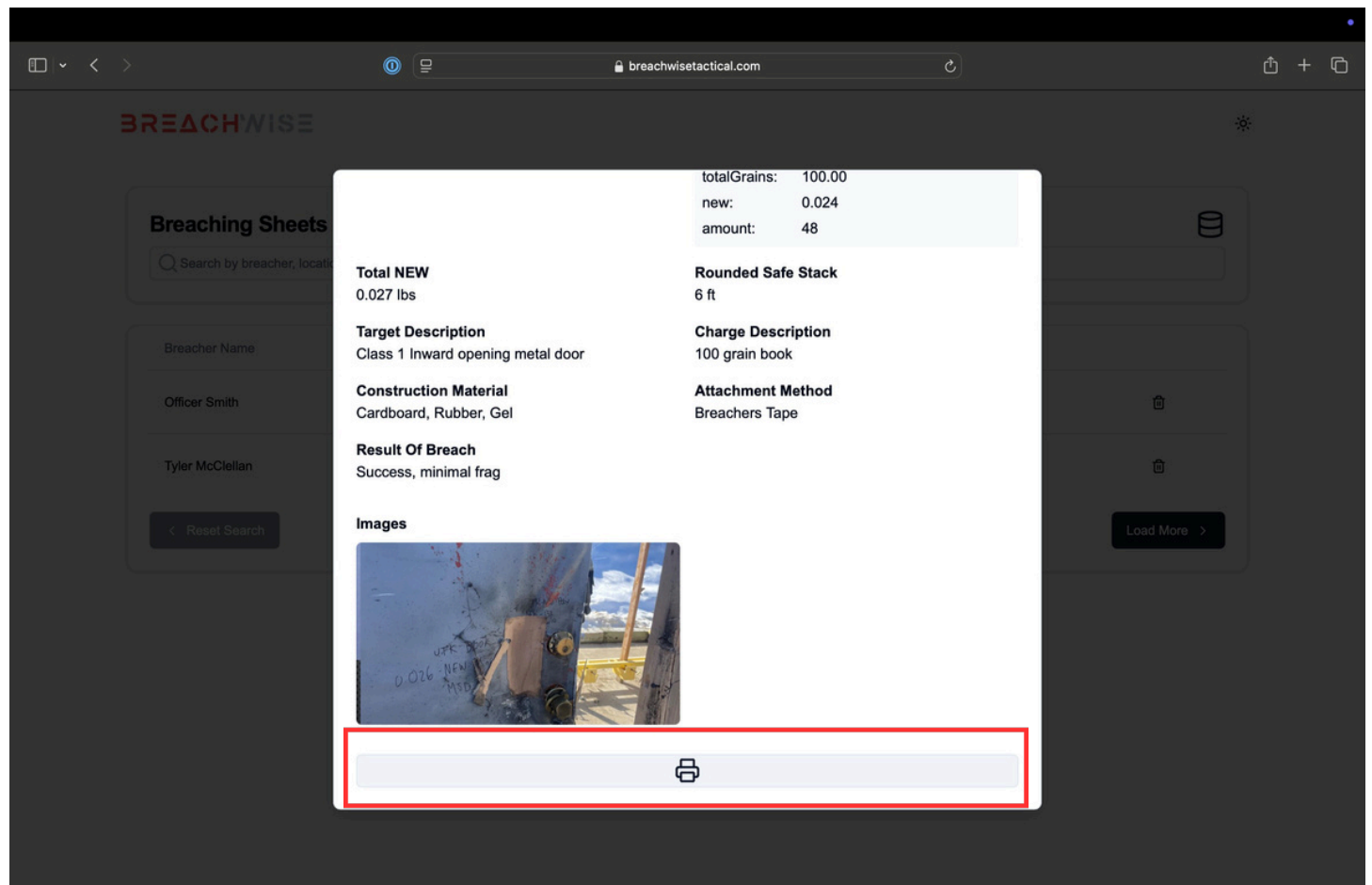

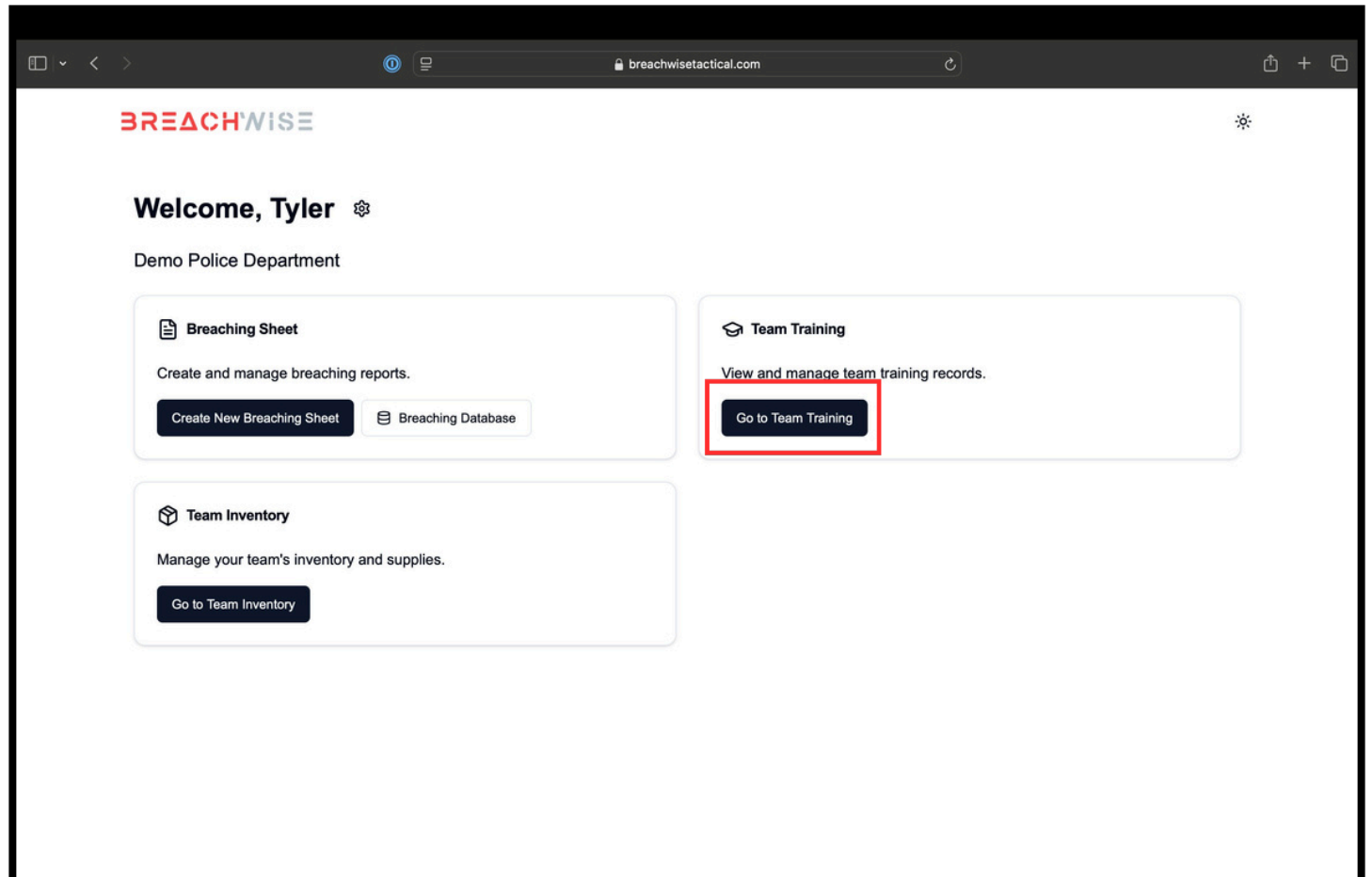

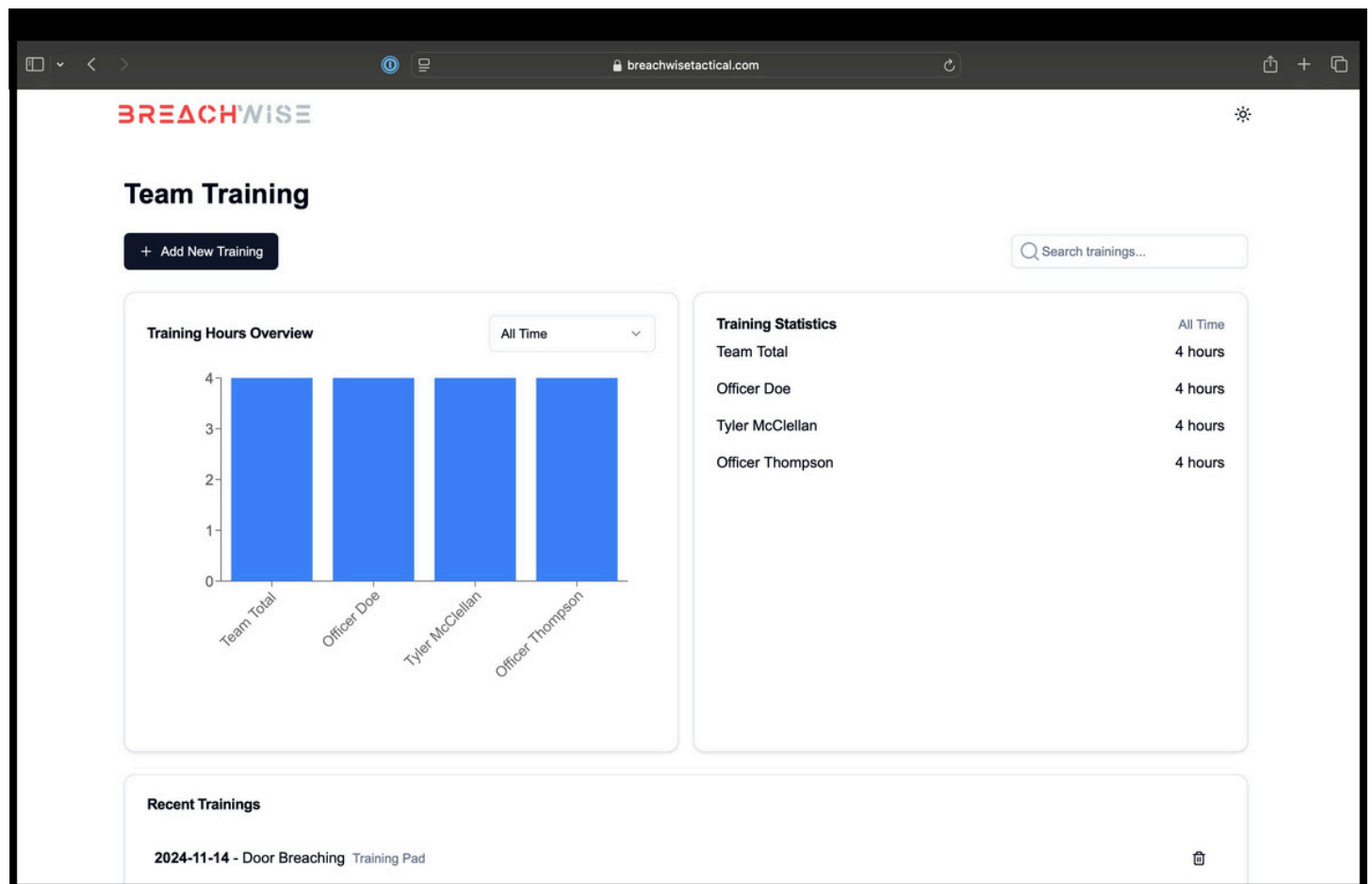
Team Training

This inventory system features a QR code implementation.

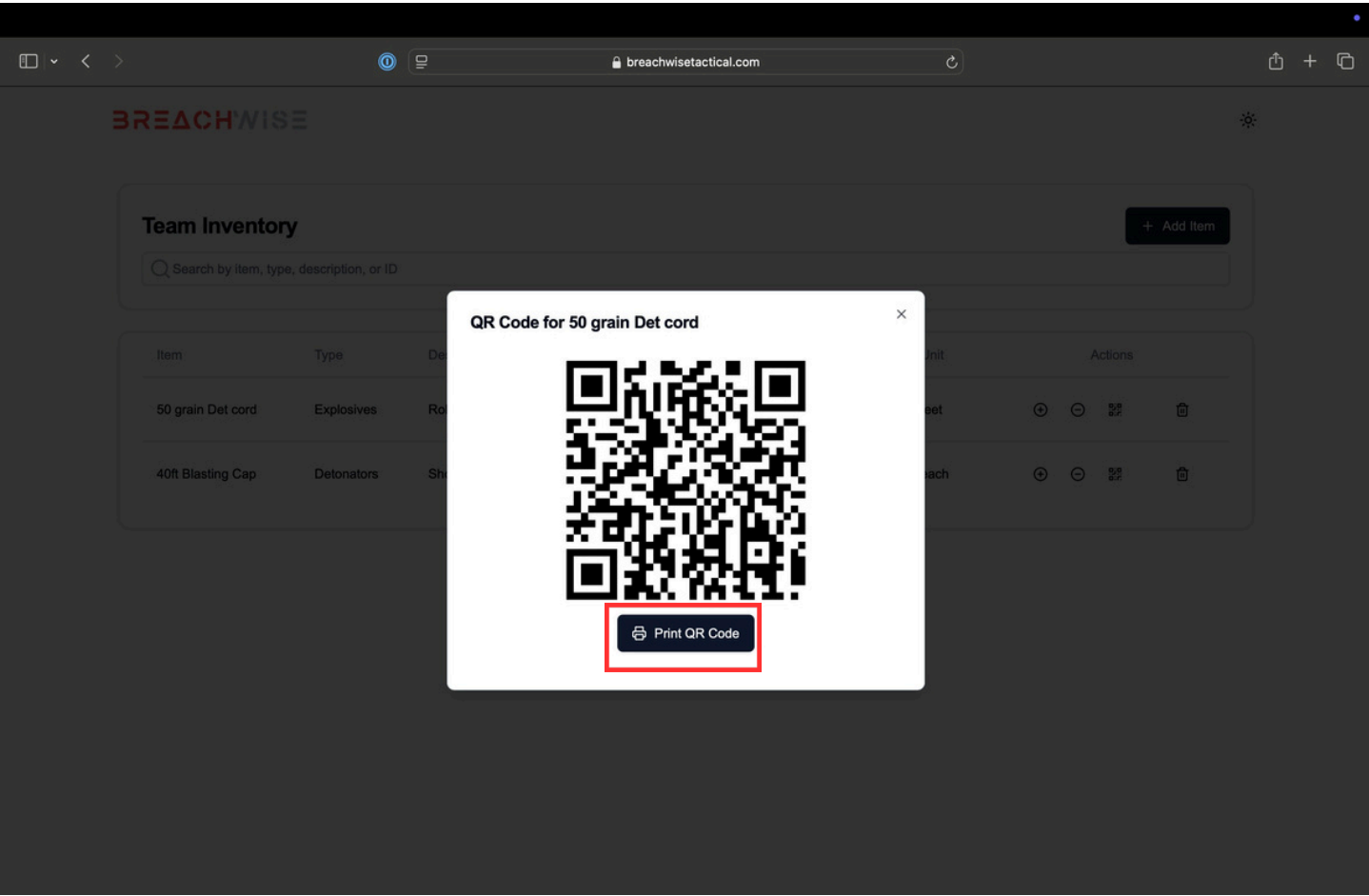
Any new item you add to inventory will automatically be assigned a new QR code. This QR code can be printed and attached to the physical item of inventory for quick access by team members.

Clicking the ‘Print QR Code’ button will bring up the printable version.

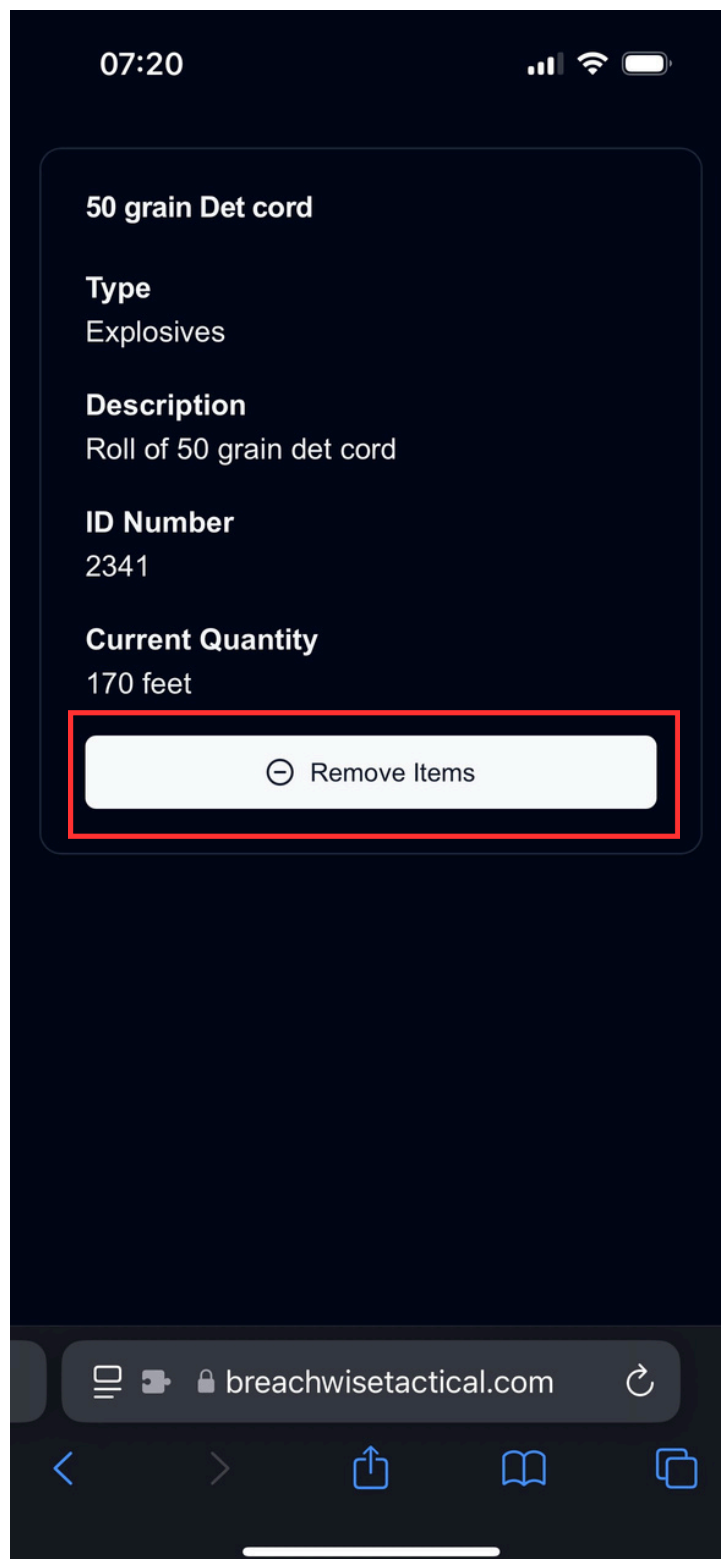
The printed version will include information about the inventory item in addition to the QR code.



Users can scan the QR code on the inventory item with their mobile device which will take them to a screen that provides them information for item and allows them to remove a certain quantity to maintain accurate inventory in the field without having to search for the item.

You will still need to login to BreachWise when scanning the QR code to maintain the security of your account and your team's inventory.

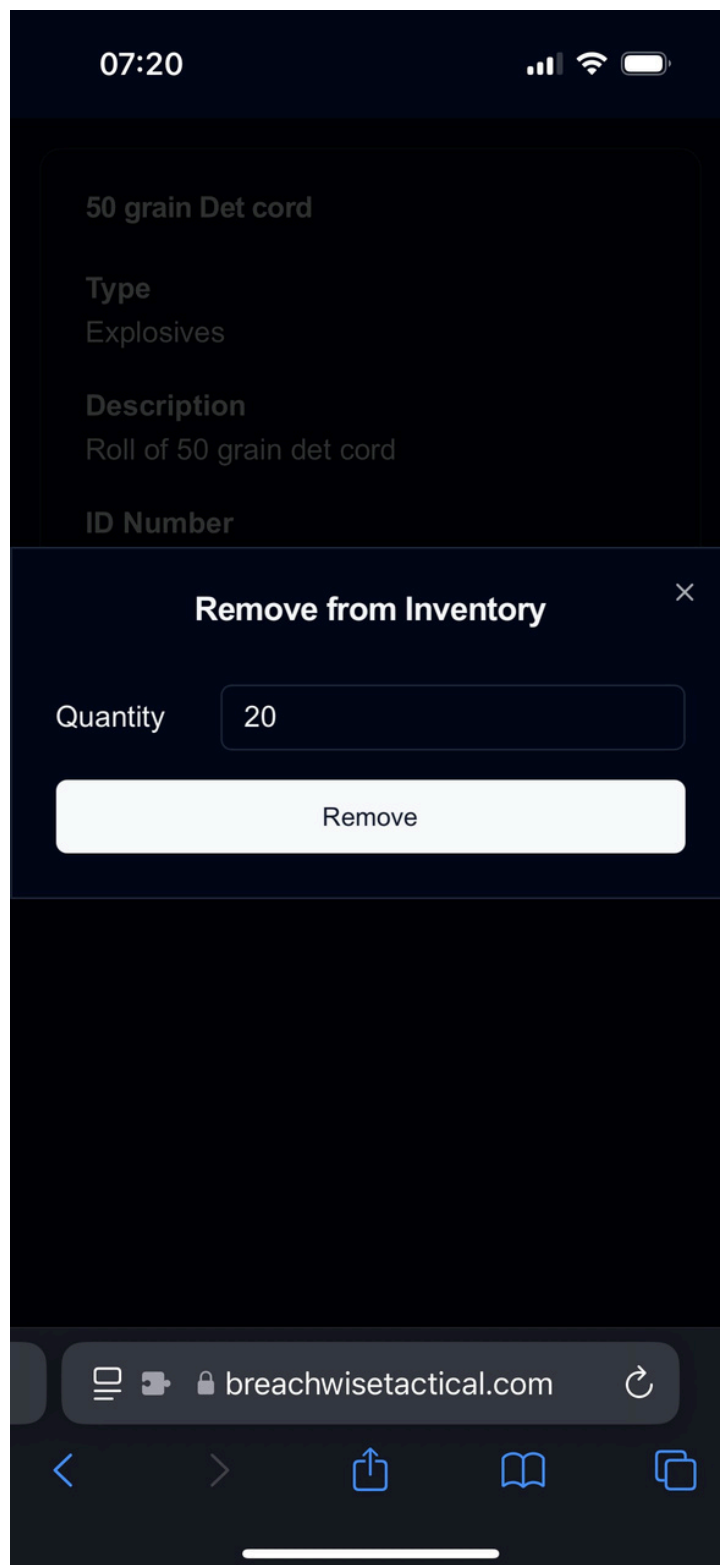
To remove items from inventory, click the 'Remove Items' button.
